Dear Vocal Music Teacher:

We are pleased to inform you once again of the exciting event organized by the Verdi Opera Theatre of Michigan, in cooperation with the Italian American Club in Livonia and the Italian American Club of Livonia Charitable Foundation: the Twenty-third annual "Italian Songs and Arias Vocal Competition for Michigan High School Students".

Our mission is to encourage and help develop talented young vocalists in the art of operatic singing and to promote appreciation for Italian classical vocal music and the Italian language. In this competition ten finalists will be selected from the music CD (not MP3 or similar, and no DVDs) auditions of each contestant's singing submitted through their respective high schools. Entries must be postmarked no later than Saturday, February 18, 2017.

Selection of the ten finalists, from all the entries received, will be completed in early March 2017. All participants will be notified of results in writing, in a letter addressed to their teacher at each respective high school, by March 20, 2017. The final competition will be in the form of a live concert, the "Concert of the Finalists", where the finalists will perform their selections with a piano accompanist, to be held on Sunday, May 7, 2017, at the beautiful Italian American Cultural Center (see attached publicity flyer for details). Each of the finalists will receive a cash prize ranging from \$50 to \$1,000, sponsored by the Italian American Club of Livonia Charitable Foundation, in addition to the opportunity to perform before a live audience. The names of the finalists and their schools will be publicized through press releases printed in newspapers and other publications.

Also available is a poster-collage of newspaper articles and photos of contestants from our previous competitions. We suggest that this poster be placed in a prominent bulletin board in your school for the students to see.
